
October 2016:


Anton contacted us through www.midascreatives to see if we could help him with some designs he created - he needed help with turning his designs into proper eyewear specification and eventually put them into production


- He was not too aware of what kind of material he could use

- He could not design but he made some sketches and he wanted professional advice


We looked at his sketches and made some suggestions and than we started to propose designs based on his ideas and provide alternative looks


















Even though Anton's sketches/designs were not professionally done they managed to show us some key elements he was looking for







Here he wanted to do a half-eye







Here he was looking to create an unique shape

This shape was too middle heavy


After further discussion we suggested that Anton could think about a combination frame with metal bridge and he came back with the below shape




And we did the same with the others

November 2016

During Oct 2016 the focus was on exchanging ideas and allowing Anton to understand what were the options available to him in terms of material, technique and how we could achieve the quality that he was looking for.

Than it was the process of mocking up designs, discuss them, refine them until we were happy and started the engineering so we could prepare for prototyping.

During the above process things like possible cost, whether new tooling would be needed to make certain metal parts etc would surface.

December 2016

Hence after 2 months of design and engineering we were able to proceed with 1st prototyping.

Once the 1st prototype was ready we would able to see what further refinements were needed.

Since we took great care in the design and engineering of the prototypes Anton was able to use them to take some photos, show them around (even to potential customers) and start preparing for marketing.






It's a lot of work, but it was also fun and very satisfying when we saw the final outcome
